(Note: How you best listen to Scripture can depend on your learning style. If you are a visual learner, then find the text in your own Bible (or pew Bible) and follow along. If you are an auditory learner, then just focus to listen with your ears and do not follow the written text. When you are reading the text for yourself outside of worship, read it ALOUD so that you both see and hear the words.)
